The SFFC aims to advance a Southern Forests Carbon Strategy to facilitate primary producers to strengthen their knowledge and initiate their carbon journey.


The project will enable the region's producers to deepen their understanding, establish their baseline, and develop, implement, and measure carbon strategies to contribute towards the region's carbon position.
